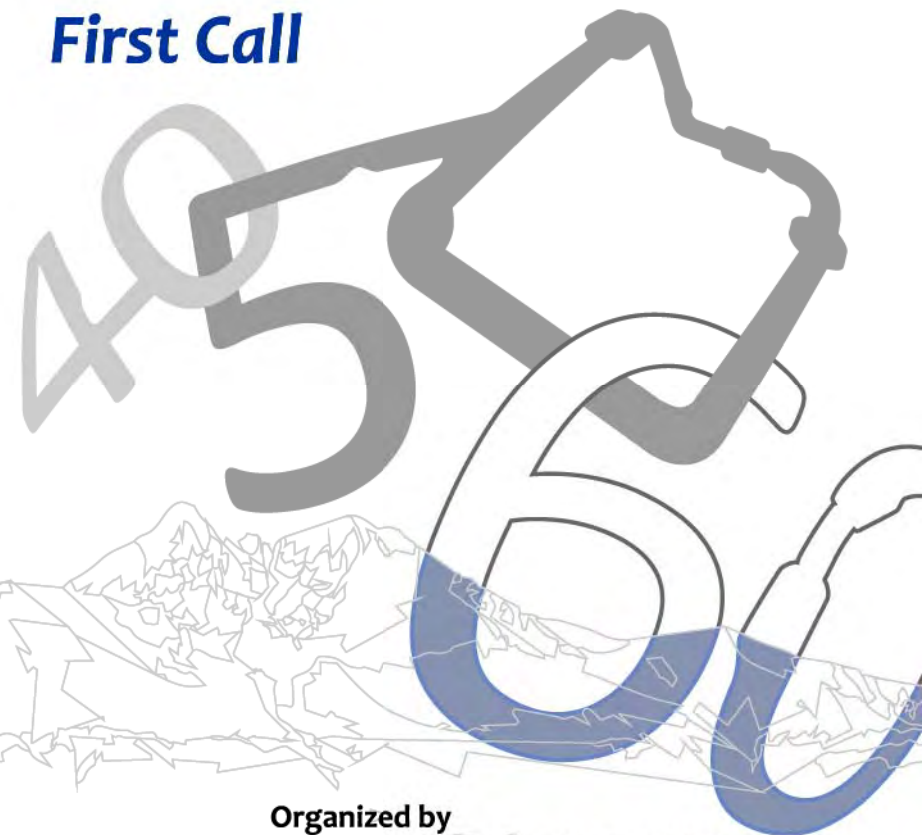

## CALL FOR CONTRIBUTIONS

Researchers are invited to apply for oral or poster presentations by January 10, 2012. These applications must be sent online using the website <http://sschi.chtf.stuba.sk/>. The Program committee will select the form of the contribution and will inform the authors about its decision by February 29, 2012. Later poster applications will be considered until the final deadline of April 15, 2012. A book of abstracts and proceedings with full-texts of contributions on CD-ROM will be published. Therefore, one-page abstracts and full-texts (recommended number of pages including figures and tables is 10) must be submitted in electronic form following the instructions on the webpage of SSCHE until April 15, 2012.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

### Lectures

Lecture time should not exceed 20 minutes including discussion. Please reduce to minimum the derivation of mathematical equations and description of data in tables. Focus on explication of principal points and the achieved results. PC with data projector will be available for authors of oral contributions.

### Posters

Posters will be presented in poster sessions. Panels for poster presentations will be available for authors (panel dimensions are 90 cm (width) x 85 cm). Poster should contain headline with the names of authors, contact information, and the title of contribution.

### Fulltexts

Fulltexts are accepted only in electronic form following the instructions on the SSCHE webpage. All figures should be inserted in the text as objects. Please, do not use the graphic tools of MS Word and do not associate the objects in the manuscripts otherwise the final electronic form could differ from the original word document.
